

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

Dear Colleague

As you are aware, Department of Drinking Water and Sanitation, Ministry of Jal Shakti runs two flagship missions viz Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) and Swachh Bharat Mission - Grameen (SBM-G), aimed at providing Drinking Water to all rural households and public institutions including schools, and to ensure effective management of solid and liquid waste in rural areas of the country. Similarly, the Department of School Education and Literacy (DoSEL), Ministry of Education, supports States and Union Territories (UTs) *inter alia* for creation and augmentation of drinking water and toilet facilities in schools across the country.

Schools play a crucial role in the education and care of young children by providing a safe and nurturing environment and good hygiene habits. In case there is lack of proper drinking water and sanitation facilities in schools, both students and staff may be vulnerable to the risk of contracting water borne diseases. Improvement of Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene (WASH) conditions and practices in schools leads to healthy childhoods, and hence better learning outcomes.

It is therefore essential that all schools have age appropriate and adequate number of toilets with running water facilities for students and staff. Apart from that, schools must also have handwashing facilities, drinking water stations, hygienic kitchen/ dining area with running water.

In the above context, it is requested that the following actions may be taken under your guidance:

1. Status of availability and sufficiency of toilets in schools may be reviewed and gaps, if any, may be addressed expeditiously. Community Sanitary Complexes may be planned and constructed, wherever necessary. Resources available under the SBM-G and the Samagra Shiksha (SS) may be utilized for this purpose.
2. Plan for providing tap water in schools for drinking, hand washing, cooking and toilets may be monitored and the residual schools may be covered as soon as possible from JJM/SS.
3. Testing of water quality, especially for biological contaminations, may be carried out on a periodic basis in all schools. Disinfection (chlorination with residual effect) of water being used in schools may be ensured for assured safety of water, especially for drinking and cooking purposes. Suitable capacity building efforts may also be undertaken for the same.
4. Support may be ensured for maintenance of the water and sanitation assets in schools. The Fifteenth Finance Commission tied grants for Water and Sanitation can be used for this purpose. Additional support may also be ensured, wherever necessary, through the funds available under the various schemes to the extent admissible, or from state/UT's own resources.

It is requested that suitable directions be issued to all concerned in this regard. It is also requested that the progress on the above-mentioned points may be periodically reviewed at your level to ensure comprehensive coverage of water and sanitation services in all schools in your State/ UT in a time bound manner, and arrangements for their sustenance.
